At Jamia Riyadhul Jannah’s Qur’ān school, we are helping parents fulfill their duty towards teaching their children how to read and understand the Qur’ān. We have set a five level syllabus for the children in which they will not only learn the Qur’ān*¹, but also Tajweed, Aqa'id*², Fiqh*³, Manners, Morals, Ahadith and memorization of different Duas and Surahs with translation.

*1- We teach Qur’ān with translation. This means that when the children read their lessons from the Qur’ān, they will also read the translation to understand the words of Allah ﷻ

*2- In Aqa'id (العقائد), we teach basic Aqa'id of AhluSunnah wa'l-Jama'ah (اهل السنة والجماعة)

*3- In Fiqh we follow the Hanafi Fiqh (الفقه الحنفي). Of course, every ruling of Fiqh is in the light of Qur’ān and Sunnah.
